Trying to print digital camera pictures?

You can use your photo printer to print off prints, but often, if and especially if you're printing a lot of photos, it's cheaper (and easier) to use an online or high street service.

Online: you can use <u>Colormailer</u> who charge between 12p and 17p per print. You really need a broadband connection to use this service, as you upload the photos over your internet connection and this would take a long time on a dial-up.

High street: <u>Boots</u> or <u>Jessops</u> offer both the high street and online services. You can either copy your chosen pictures to a CD or memory card and pop in, or use their online service from home.

Can't switch off your laptop or desktop?

If your laptop has blue-screened, and you can't switch it off, you don't have to take the battery out. Simply hold the power (on/off) button until the machine switches off. This works for desktops too, but you should only do this as a last resort if your machine won't switch off.



Viruses on your mobile phone?

Yes, believe it or not you can get a virus on your phone. It's only possible if you have one of a number of smartphones, and only if you connect to the internet with it.
