Broadband Downloads and Uploads



Broadband - whether it's ADSL, which is provided over a BT phone line, or cable, which is provided by NTL or Telewest Broadband (now merged) - is getting faster. To keep customers paying the same rates, the providers are increasing the download speeds of most internet connections, and adding new users at the original slower speeds, at lower prices.

If you are not worried about keeping your provider's email address (if you have your own domain name, for example), you could save money by switching to a different tariff, or to another provider. Have a look at [Uswitch](#) for more information, or [contact us](#).

Wireless Freedom



Some people still use the small modems that they received from their internet service provider. With some exceptions (notably some AOL accounts), you can replace this with a router and share your broadband connection between two or more PCs/Macs. If you choose a wireless router, you can also connect your wireless-equipped desktops and laptops and work anywhere within wireless range. These routers also act as firewalls to provide more protection for your computers. Contact [Tabard IT](#) for more information.
